The patent battle between MHI and GE over variable-speed wind turbine technology ended January 8 in favor of MHI. The ITC ruling cleared MHI to sell its 2.4 MW machine in the U.S. market without altering its technology or obtaining a license from GE. The patent case breathes life into MHI's efforts to expand its market share in the U.S. and also highlights the increasingly competitive multi-megawatt segment in the U.S. market.
